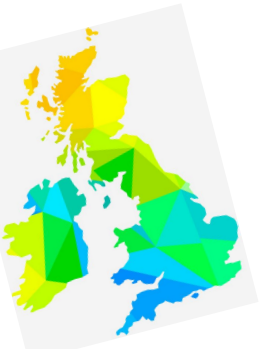

In the PRE department, we are passionate about enabling students to becoming 'Curious learners through confident discussion' when investigating 'What it means to be human'

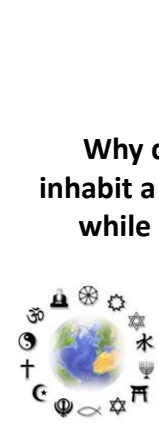
Begin the journey into 'Religion and worldviews', considering the individual values and beliefs to the familial.

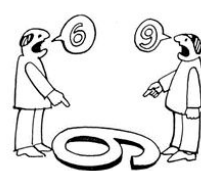
